We have proposed a Project KA2 for innovation and exchange of good practice, named 'Run from one country to another', between two schools, Italian and Romanian. The duration of the project is 18 months, starting from the September 2018.

The objectives are the following: 1) Objective: Understanding of the role of sport and physical activity in society (tools for inclusion) and in a wider world. 2) Objective: A personal wellbeing and with others, for a better society (social inclusion and improvement of life skills and competence) 3) Objective: Understanding of effectiveness and safe performance 4) Objective: Lifelong skills development, in particular citizenship and entrepreneurship skills.

The number and profile of participants are: 21 Students for each school, from 14 to 16 years old. The activities will be done in the school partners, during 2 school mobilities and online, with eTwinning platform.

Methodology: -ecological approach (In ecological-dynamic approach, skill learning is to seek the adaptability of the movement as resulting by the diversity of the environment and the specificity of the individual) - cognitive approach for motor control - problem solving - brainstorming - giving



instructions and roles - group and pair work (group processing) - create dynamic group - encourage creativity - co-operative learning

The results are: 1. Objective Tangible: chart, poster, Intangible: physic and psychic wellbeing, improved endurance, mental relax, better concentration, and development of self-esteem, respect of diversity.

2. Objective Tangible: poster with exercises images, video tutorial, or audio guide (autogenic training and meditation) Intangible: improved concentration and stress managing; better school results and overcome dissipation.

3. Objective Tangible: tools for activity, snowshoes, sticks. Reportage of the experience: poster and pictures of the activity; video; e-book; drone, Geocaching APP; creation of wellness path. Intangible: awareness about safety, person's role, skills, right self-behaviour, with others and environment, team collaboration.

4. Objective Tangible: school equipment, digital chart with reported result of performance, assessment chart, self-evaluation chart Intangible: satisfaction in outdoing obstacles, improved self-confidence, knowledge of their abilities and skills.

The project has also a communication, monitoring, evaluation and dissemination plan. The sustainability of the project will be:

- write an innovation project with other countries, involving University and searching new stakeholders
- write a project about SPORT, in a small collaborative partnership
- insert the results in our school curriculum, available to the other classes.
